Course purpose and objectives	<p>The aim of the course is to expose students to the real world of the labour market and to positions where a law degree is required or a job can be provided by a holder of such a degree. In this way, students will have a more realistic understanding of how the law is applied in practice in order to be able to understand and also apply the law in practice. Furthermore, the aim is, as with the student's contact with various jobs, to help him in his further professional orientation. Also, the aim of the course is to link academic knowledge with the practical application of legal science, to build students' communication skills and to acquire relevant professional experience</p>
