Program Requirements

The European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS) is a tool of the European Higher Education Area that makes studies and courses more transparent. It helps students move between countries and have their academic qualifications and periods of study abroad recognized. The credit units below are based on ECTS.

90 ECTS credits are required for the completion of the program.

- Engage in continuous learning by staying updated on recent developments in educational psychology and related fields through conference participation and professional development opportunities.
- Demonstrate strong communication skills, both written and oral, for effective collaboration with students, educators, parents, and other stakeholders, including the ability to adapt communication to different cultural and individual needs.
- Demonstrate capacity for innovation and adaptation of educational psychology practices to respond to evolving educational needs, including the integration of technology and online counseling.
- Understand and appreciate cultural diversity and demonstrate the ability to adapt educational interventions to meet the unique needs of different students and their cultural backgrounds.
- Demonstrate leadership capabilities in promoting positive changes within educational institutions and influencing policies and practices that enhance the educational experience.
